 6. Student must be a High School graduate from Nashville, TN.
 7. Mr. Edward Boyd will submit the final decision for the recipients of this scholarship.

Purpose:

- To perpetuate pride in the Pearl High Heritage Classes legacy and an awareness thereof.
- To reward academic excellence.
- To encourage students who are pursuing a career in Engineering or Computer Science
- To encourage higher education aspirations among descendants and non-descendants of Pearl High School alumni.

Amount:

Upon notification of acceptance by student's preferred postsecondary institution, an amount of \$1,000 (minimum) will be deposited by the Scholarship Committee in the scholarship recipient's student account at the chosen college or university. This is a renewable scholarship for five (5) years. Students must maintain a 2.5 GPA.

Eligibility and Statement:

- Applicant must be committed to **major in Engineering or Computer Science**
- It would be helpful to know if the student is a Pearl High School descendant or non-descendant who is committed to attend a Historical Black College or University (HBCU). However, this is not a requirement.

Requirements:

- Student must have maintained a high school cumulative GPA of 2.5 or better.
- Student must complete an application form.
- Student must indicate a desire for a scholarship by submitting a **350-500 word typewritten, two (2)-page biographical sketch that includes post-secondary goals (not to exceed 500 words)**.
- Student must submit a **non-returnable recent photo**.
- Student must submit **two (2) letters of recommendation** – one from a person in each of the following categories:
 1. School Personnel, i.e. counselor, principal or teacher.
 2. Community Person, i.e. pastor, Sunday School teacher, community official.
- Student must submit an **OFFICIAL** copy of the high school transcript (embossed with the school's seal), including ACT/SAT scores, GPA and class rank.
- Student must be a high school graduate from Nashville, TN
- Mr. Edward Boyd will submit the final decision for the recipients of this scholarship.
- **Parent(s)/Guardian** must complete all items included in the Family and Financial Analysis section.
