KATHERINE R. SKAGGS SCHOLARSHIP

The Sumner County School Nutrition Association will award, to a senior of a Sumner County High School, a \$500.00 scholarship to be used at the college of their choice in the State of Tennessee. Each high school shall recommend one student for this scholarship to the School Nutrition Association for final approval. Any incomplete applications will not be considered.

Basis for selection:

1. Must maintained a minimum grade point average of 2.5 or above. The higher the grade point average the more advantageous it will be for the application (10 points will be given for 3.0 average or above and 7 points will be given for 2.5 - 3.0 average).
2. Plans to major in Human Ecology, Nutrition, Food Services, Elementary Education or any field relating to food service would be preferred but not totally necessary.
3. Student may be male or female.
4. Scholarship may be used at any junior college, college, vocational tech school or university in the State of Tennessee.
5. Student must be enrolled in a college before scholarship will be paid. Scholarship will be paid directly to the chosen educational facility.
6. Scholarship shall not apply to meals or room rent. Shall apply to tuition, books, lab supplies only.
7. Scholarship shall be awarded in addition to any other scholarships.
8. The students must have completed the entire year at a public high school in Sumner County.
9. Major considerations in selecting the award winner will be citizenship, academic aptitude, attendance, financial need, and the desire for a higher education.
10. The student must file a scholarship application for the award including a statement concerning plans for higher education (2 pages).
11. Supply at least one reference from a teacher or administrator from the school you are attending.
12.
