

1. Online registration is open! Log into your Skyward account and complete the online registration BEFORE you attend Golden Opportunity (referred to as GO as this email continues). Anyone not completing the online portion will be redirected during GO to complete this before you will be allowed to complete other tasks. Here is a Skyward link for your convenience:

2. Golden Opportunity. GO is scheduled for July 25 for Seniors and Juniors and July 26 for Sophomores and Freshmen. Both days are from 4-7 PM. It is a come-by, complete, and leave event. The more you have ready when you come the quicker you will complete the event. There are two forms that cannot be completed online. I have included them here: [Health Form](#) and [McKinney Vento Form](#) Please fill these out and bring them with you. It will save you time! We will have these forms available on site should you forget or not complete them prior to GO. GO is to be attended by the student and at least one parent. If you do not attend GO you will not be able to receive your schedule or complete any other tasks until the first day of school on Aug 1.

3, GO will give you the opportunity to purchase athletic passes, turn in all forms, apply for meal benefits (if needed), order class tee shirts, buy Commando gear, get your schedule, get your parking pass (if eligible), get your ID, pay fees, etc.

9. Please read carefully this new information regarding parking at HHS. Due to the growing numbers of students, HHS will implement a policy of allowing ONLY Juniors and Seniors to park on campus. We have approximately 484 spots available for student parking. We have a Junior class of 425 students and a Senior class of 392 students totaling 817 combined. As you can see there is not even enough parking to accommodate that number of students. Parking for Jr and Sr will remain on a first-come-first-served basis. I will be sending a link to Sr and Jr families

shortly to apply for your parking pass. If you do not have a parking pass, DO NOT park on campus. You will be ticketed and possibly towed. There will be no consideration of hardships for Sophomores please do not ask for an exception.

10. I mentioned Athletic Passes earlier. The Athletic Passes at \$50 are a great way to save money. Five home football games total \$35 alone. Throw in 10 to 12 home basketball games at \$6 and 5-7 home soccer games in the fall at \$6 and you can see it would save your student a lot of money. Athletic Passes are for students only. We will have more information and a link to purchase a little closer to GO.
